Number 1

- Recognise number 1
- Identify the quantity 1
- Count 1 object from a larger group
- Find 1 on the clock
- Shape - circle
- Know that 1 is 1 more than 0
- 1p and £1
- Introduce patterns
- Number sentences $1+0=1$

Week 4

Number 2

- Recognise number 2
- Identify the quantity 2
- Count 2 objects from a larger group
- Find 2 on the clock
- Shape - semicircle
- Know that 2 is 1 more than 1
- Know that 2 is 2 more than 0
- 2p and £2 coins
- Number bonds to 2
- Continue a 2 step pattern
- Number sentences to make 2

Week 5

Number 3

- Recognise number 3
- Identify the quantity 3
- Count 3 objects from a larger group
- Find 3 on the clock
- Shape with 3 sides - triangle
- Know that 3 is 1 more than 2
- Know that 3 is 2 more than 1
- Make 3p/£3
- Number bonds to 3
- Continue a 3 step pattern
- Number sentences to make 3

Week 6

Revise 1,2,3

- Identify how many objects are in a set
- There is no 3p coin. How can we make 3p?
- Identify different types of triangles - they all have 3 sides
- One more/one less
- Shapes pattern
- Number bonds to 3
- Making number 2,3 using number sentences

Week 7

Revise 1,2,3

- Order numbers from 1 to 3
- Find the missing number
- One more than 1 and 2
- Circle, semicircle, triangle
- One less than 1,2,3
- Continue a simple pattern
- Compare the numbers 'bigger' / 'smaller'
- Recognise which set of object contains 1,2,3 - subitise
