### Statement

### Aims of Safeguarding Procedure and practice at Millbrook School.

- To provide a safe school in which we actively promote the safety of every child.
- To provide a safe environment where children feel secure, are encouraged to express their feelings on matters relating to safety and are listened to when they have a worry or concern.
- To ensure that the children know that there are adults in the school whom they can approach if they are worried.
- To provide regular Safeguarding training to all staff so that they are knowledgeable and aware of their role and of the appropriate procedures to follow.
- To provide a message to all adults within our community, that we are a safe school.
- To embed messages about Personal Safety into our curriculum.
