- Rewards – punctuality and attendance

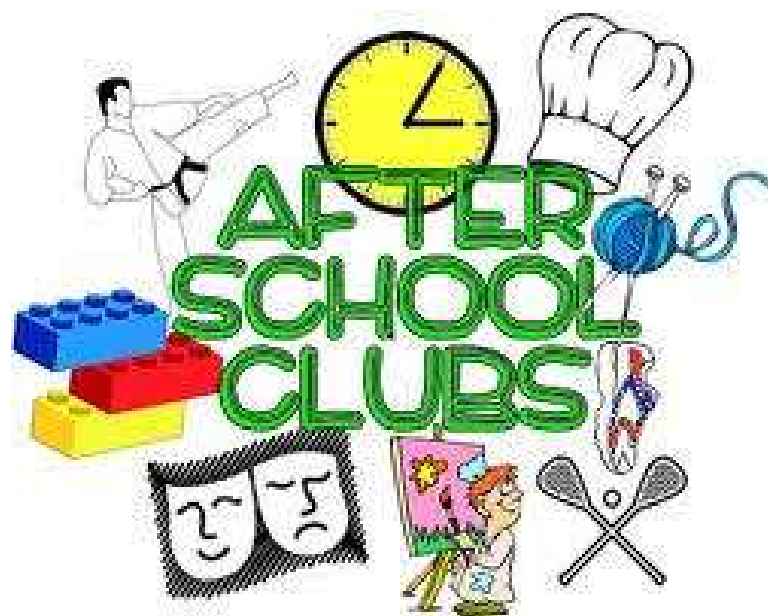
