We are delighted to be welcoming Actualise Learning into Millbrook Primary School to offer an exciting Chocolate Brownie Making After-School Club for pupils in Years 3 to 6.

This fun and engaging course is designed to help pupils develop an appreciation for the origins of chocolate while fostering creativity through designing, making, and decorating their own chocolate treats. The activities will also promote teamwork through group-based tasks and build an understanding of sustainable and ethical chocolate production.

### Club details

- The club will run for six weeks, starting on Tuesday 11th November, for one hour after school.
- A minimum of 20 pupils is required for the course to go ahead.
- The cost of the full six-week course is £36.00 per pupil, payable in advance.
- Children will also need to bring an apron from home for each session.
- Places are limited to 25 pupils and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis

To secure your child's place on the course please sign up and make payment via your school gateway app by Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> November.

Parents who would like to access their additional chocolate-making modules and enrichment resources for home use can do so for £2.50 per module, or £15 for a set of six one-hour home-based activities.
