Aims

It is the policy of Bonneygrove School that all children will wear our agreed uniform each day. This fosters a feeling of belonging to our community, and helps children feel equal to each other.

Bonneygrove School uniform can be purchased from Mapac with the school logo on (not compulsory) or from supermarkets/clothing retailers without the logo. Sample sizes are available to view in school. Details can be found at the end of this policy. Note: Uniform is not compulsory for Nursery children.

Please ensure ALL items brought into school are clearly labelled with your child's name.

		<p>Burgundy sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan (with or without school logo)</p>
		<p>Grey skirt Grey pinafore Grey trousers Grey shorts Red and white gingham check dress for summer. Children in Reception classes are permitted to wear either black or dark grey joggers instead of school trousers.</p>
		<p>White long or short sleeved shirt with clip on tie (boys and girls) Tie (£4.50) can be purchased from the school office – exact cash/card reader or Wisepay.</p> <p>We expect children to wear clothing that they can remove easily themselves. For this reason, polo shirts are preferred instead of shirts.</p>



Boys - Grey/black socks

Girls - Grey/black/white socks/tights



In order to promote independence, we expect your child to wear appropriate BLACK footwear.

Shoes with easy fastenings such as Velcro are preferred, as this will allow your child to put on and take off their shoes independently. **Flipflops, Uggs, Converse, trainers, Crocs or scuba shoes are not part of the school uniform.**



Outdoor/Raincoat

A coat with a hood is highly recommended for your child, to access the outdoor classroom in wet weather.

A burgundy fleece with the school logo is also available from Mapac (details at the bottom of this policy).



Book Bag (with school logo)

This will enable your child to take home reading books and homework on a regular basis.

Book bags (£4.50) can be purchased from the school office – please bring exact cash in a sealed envelope with your child's name on the front.



PE Kit / PE Bag (with school logo)

Plain white **round** neck T-shirt, black/burgundy shorts and black/burgundy jogging bottoms.

PE bags (£3.50) can be purchased from the school office – please bring exact cash in a sealed envelope with your child's name on the front.

Hair Accessories

Hair accessories should be kept to a minimum and if worn should be either grey, black or burgundy.

Nursery and Reception Children ONLY



Spare Clothes Bag

This should contain an entire change of clothes, including socks and underwear.



Wellington boots

Your child is required to have Wellington boots that will remain in school for outdoor learning.

Please ensure ALL items brought into school are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Please do not bring the following items into school:

Snacks	KS1 children will receive a piece of fruit or vegetables and water daily. We are a nut-free school.
Jewellery	For health and safety reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted in school. Very small, stud earrings can be worn, but on PE lesson days, these should be removed or taped over at home
