English		Maths	
In English, we will be focusing on a unit of letter writing, where children will learn how to write letters. They will also write a narrative, consolidating knowledge from previous units.		In Maths, we will be continuing our learning on number and place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.	
Reading		Science	
This half term, we are linking our reading to our wider foundation subjects, to include further learning about pollution and recycling.		In Science, we are going to be learning about states of matter. Our unit is called 'The Changing Crew,' where we will explore solids, liquids and gases as well as evaporation and condensation.	
DT		Geography	
We will be exploring levers, pulleys and axles to create a moving playground. The mechanisms will form a key part of their finished designs.		In Geography, we will be exploring the topic 'Planet Protectors.' In this unit, we will understand what we can do to protect our planet from pollution and climate change.
