Year 6 SATS Update and Breakfast

We are extremely proud of the effort being made by our Year 6 students as they prepare for their end of Key stage 2 tests (SATS), and we would like to thank you for the ongoing support that you are giving your child with their home-learning. We are certain that every child will try their very best, and their results will reflect the effort they've given.

As you know, SATs week begins on Monday 11th May 2026 (timetable included below). To enable the children to come into school and feel relaxed, we will be running a Breakfast Club each morning from 8.10am.
